



I-20 Request Form and Proof of Finances Instructions

Please read the instructions and requirements carefully before submitting your financial documents

What is a Form I-20?

- x The Certificate of Eligibility Form I-20 is a U.S. government form that EFSC uses to certify that you are eligible for F-1 status. You need an I-20 to obtain an F-1 student visa and to keep lawful F-1 status when transferring or changing schools in the U.S.

What financial proof do I need to submit to get an I-20?

- x Bank statement or bank letter showing a minimum of \$22,426.00 USD
- x

Acceptable Documents

- x Bank Statement OR
- x Bank Letter on letterhead
- x Dated within last 90 days
- x Balance shows a specific dollar amount

NOT Accepted

- x Employer letters, stocks or bonds, personal statements, asset appraisals, investment accounts etc.
- x Balance listed as "enough" or "sufficient funds"
