Procedure for Obtaining Credit

Student must meet the following criteria:

- x Meet all EFSC admissions requirements pertaining to entering the program listed above, including placement testing and transcripts on file.
- x Be an active student currently enrolled in the program listed above and in good academic standing.
- x Student's major must reflect the program listed in the agreement.
- x Correctional Certification must be current and NOT EXPIRED at the time the credit will be awarded.
- x Complete 25% of the EFSC AS/Criminal Justice credits in residency prior to petitioning for credit.
- x Submit the completed, approved, and signed "Petition for Articulated Credit" form, including a copy of the Correctional Certification and all transcripts for Certification training to:

 - o EFSC, Office of the Registrar, 1519 Clearlake Road, Cocoa, FL 32922.
- x The student will not be charged tuition or fees for the postsecondary credit awarded.
- x Credit will be awarded with grade of "S" which will not affect the student's grade point average.
- x Duplicate credit will not be awarded.
- x Degrees or certificates are not conferred unless a minimum of 25% of the degree or certificate program requirements are completed through traditional coursework taken at EFSC.
