4. Successfully complete 11 credits of the major courses within the program, including specified EFSC program courses. Specified courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher.

eligible for dual enrollment may take the specified courses while they are in high school.

- a. Student will follow degree requirements of the catalog in effect at the time of admission to the

College.

- b. If student does not maintain continuous enrollment at EFSC, student will follow requirements of the catalog in effect at the time of readmission
5. Student must complete 12 Credits of the degree requirements through traditional coursework at EFSC.
6. Upon completion of the above requirements, student must submit the *Petition for Articulated Credit Form* through the Office of Career and Technical Programs or the Office of the Registrar.

Address questions regarding this agreement to the appropriate EFSC program faculty, the EFSC Office of Career and Technical Programs, the EFSC Office of the Registrar, or the BPS Director, Career and Technical Education.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall be effective upon the signature of the BPS Superintendent or designee and the EFSC President or designee. This agreement shall be reviewed every two years, and will remain in effect until revoked or terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice prior to the end of a term or by mutual consent.
